Non-Uniform Day The Big Pink: Breast Cancer Care - 18th October 2019

October is Breast Cancer Awareness month, and this year we are joining in by supporting *The Big Pink* in having a non-uniform day on Friday 18th October. Many of us know someone who has been affected by breast cancer, so we are asking students to support this important cause.

Students are being asked to pay £2 to wear home clothes, and where possible, to wear something pink to show our support for Breast Cancer Care. Money will be collected from form groups by Sixth Formers from Monday 7th October. As well as non-uniform there will be other fundraising activities through the week and a cake sale on Friday 18th October.

As parents/carers you are asked to give consideration to the clothing choices of your child particularly if they travel on public transport, to avoid unwanted attention from strangers.

Normal uniform rules will apply with regard to make up, hair and jewellery.

Please dress sensibly and appropriately for a day working at school, this includes:

- no ripped jeans;
- no shorts or mini-skirts;
- tops should cover shoulders and stomach;
- no flip flops, sandals or sliders (this reduces the risk of tripping on the stairs or exposed toes being stepped on in crowded corridors);
- no fancy dress or onesies;
- PE/Dance kit as usual if you have those lessons.
