Dear Parents/Carer(s),

I wrote to you earlier in the school year to clarify the School's expectations on uniform. In these final days of the summer term I wish to reiterate the importance for all students in Years 7 – 11 to arrive at school wearing the correct skirt.

- a) For Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 the school skirt is a **plain brown kilt style pleated skirt**. It has a waist band with the school logo. It should be of knee length.
- b) Students in the Sixth Form have the opportunity to wear a plain brown skirt, **straight style with a single pleat at the back**.

ONLY the pleated skirt will be acceptable and no other style must be worn. Any student who may have mistakenly purchased the straight style in the past should take this opportunity to replace it.

The School's uniform supplier Red Oak Roller have assistants who are both helpful and knowledgeable in the guidance they offer and I would ask parents to be directed by them.
