Uniform Requirements



Our Sixth Form uniform is a reflection of the high standards, professionalism, and sense of community we expect from all our students as they prepare for life beyond school. All students must adhere to the Sixth Form uniform policy at all times.

We recommend that uniform is not purchased prior to an enrolment to Sixth Form.

Sixth Form Students will wear the Formal Uniform for most of their school days. The Practical Uniform will be worn if students have PE lessons or a practical session on a BTEC course; these sessions will be made clear to Sixth Form students.

Our Formal Uniform

Sixth Form students must wear **Version A** or **Version B** of the uniform. It is not permitted for students to mix and match from the two versions.

Practical Uniform

Plain, black, round-neck sweatshirt with BUCHS logo to be purchased from Red Oak Roller, our school uniform supplier	
Plain black polo shirt with BUCHS logo to be purchased from our school uniform supplier	Plain black round-neck T-shirt
Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no logos and no patterns are permitted)	Plain black leggings – these must be full length, without panelling or logos and without any transparent sections.
Black sport socks (no pattern)	White sport socks (no pattern)
Plain black trainers (non-marking soles and preferably without branding)	Plain white trainers (non-marking soles and preferably without branding)

This version of the uniform will be worn by Sixth Form students in lessons when they are timetabled a practical activity, such as PE or Performing Arts. It may also be worn for Curriculum Enrichment Days or other outdoor activities as directed and agreed by teachers.

Students for BTEC Performing Arts will also need a plain black leotard but this must be changed into at school and not worn to or from the school site.

SIXTH FORM JEWELLERY & MAKEUP

- Subtle/discreet makeup may be worn.
- Subtle/discreet nail varnish may be worn. Gel or acrylic nails are not permitted.
- Nails to be kept at a safe and professional length.
- Subtle/discreet jewellery may be worn (no dangly earrings, maximum of two piercings in each ear). No other embellishments to be worn.
- No facial or body piercings to be visible, including nose studs and tongue piercings.
- Extremes of hair-style are not permitted.
- Hair-dying is discouraged and non-natural colours are not permitted.
- No forms of tattoo or body art are permitted, including on face, neck, arms or hands.

THE SCHOOL RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DECIDE ON 'DISCREET', 'SUBTLE', 'EXTREME', 'SAFE' AND 'PROFESSIONAL'.

Persistent or extreme infringement of uniform rules will result in Sixth Form Leadership Team intervention and this may include parental contact, withdrawal from lessons and / or the student being sent home until the uniform infringement is put right.
