## Sixth Form Conditions of Enrolment for 2026 Entry

All offers of places to study A levels or a National Diploma at the Brentwood Ursuline are conditional on you attaining the required grades at GCSE.

- To study **3** A Level subjects: **48 points** at GCSE from **your best 8 GCSE subjects**.
- To study **1** National Diploma (equivalent in size to two A Level courses) with **1** A Level: **25 points** at GCSE.

To calculate your points, please review your GCSE grades awarded and check the points:

Each individual subject in the Sixth Form has specific entry requirements, which students must meet in order to study the subject. These subject specific entry requirements are found on the following page.

Sixth form students not achieving a GCSE Grade 4 or above in Maths and/or English language will need to re-sit and attend extra classes at BUCHS,

## Subject Specific Requirements – A level subjects

<b>Art</b>	Grade 6 or above in Art	<b>History</b>	Grade 6 in History or another Humanities subject if History has not previously been studied and Grade 6 in English
<b>Biology</b>	Grade 66 in Combined Science or a Grade 6 in Biology and Grade 6 in another Science, plus Grade 6 in Maths	<b>Law</b>	Grade 5 in English and Grade 5 in a Humanities subject.
<b>Chemistry</b>	Grade 77 in Combined Science or Grade 7 in Chemistry, plus Grade 6 in Maths	<b>Mathematics</b>	Grade 7 in Maths
<b>Computer Science</b>	Grade 6 in Computer Science and Grade 6 in Maths	<b>Music</b>	Grade 6 in Music and Grade 6 standard in one instrument or voice, plus a good knowledge of the rudiments of music theory
<b>Dance</b>	Grade 4 in English. A proficiency in Dance as evidenced by a GCSE in Dance and/or extra-curricular involvement.	<b>Physical Education</b>	Grade 6 in Biology or Physical Education and Grade 5 in English Language
<b>Drama</b>	Grade 4 in English. A proficiency in Drama as evidenced by a GCSE in Drama and/or extra-curricular involvement.	<b>Physics</b>	Grade 66 in Combined Science or Grade 6 in Physics, plus Grade 7 in Maths
<b>Economics</b>	Grade 6 in Maths and Grade 6 in English Language/Literature	<b>Politics</b>	Grade 5 in English Literature and Grade 6 in another Humanities Subject. An interest in current affairs and politics is imperative.
<b>English Literature</b>	Grade 6 in English Language and English Literature	<b>Psychology</b>	Grade 5 in English Language, English Literature and Maths
<b>French</b>	Grade 6 in French and Grade 5 in English Language	<b>Religious Studies</b>	Grade 6 in Religious Education or a Humanities subject, plus Grade 6 in English
<b>Further Maths</b>	Grade 8 in Maths	<b>Spanish</b>	Grade 6 in Spanish and Grade 5 in English Language
<b>Geography</b>	Grade 6 in Geography or another Humanities subject if Geography has not previously been studied and Grade 6 in English	<b>Textiles</b>	Grade 6 in Art or Textiles

## Subject Specific Requirements – National diplomas

<b>Business</b>	5 GCSEs at Grade 5 or above. A good level of numeracy and literacy is essential.
<b>Performing Arts</b>	5 GCSEs at Grade 5 or above. Experience within the field of performing arts is desired but not essential.
<b>Applied Science</b>	5 GCSEs at Grade 5 or above. A proficiency for Science is essential as evidenced by results and/or teacher recommendation.
