For English at university there will be a range of different subject choices ranging from creative writing to studying Anglo-Saxon to 20th Century texts and also the chance to study linguistics, which is the study of language and its acquisition.

For History this can range from the study of classical civilization and ancient history to 20th Century history. This could also lead into degrees such as Middle Eastern or European Studies. History would be a combined well with other subjects like Politics or Languages. You could also specialize in areas such as the History of Art.

For Religious Studies this could lead onto degrees in Theology, Islamic Studies, Ethics and Philosophy or Religious Studies. Content will range from studying purely Christianity to World Religions and the Philosophical thinking linked to the study of ideas of Religion. You could learn languages such as Ancient Greek, Latin, Hebrew or other languages used in religious texts as part of the degree.
